These are for the graduation program and slide show and **MUST** be turned in on time to be included in these productions. We need one baby or toddler photo, one recent activity/interest photo, and one senior portrait head shot.

March 1st - Send email to the EFCA office stating intent to graduate with full name to be printed on the diploma and whether or not you will participate in the graduation ceremony.

April 15th - Submit application for valedictorian/Salutatorian, if interested, to EFCA office- the application is located on the senior tab of website.

May 9th – Final grades due to EFCA office. How many parents will be going on to the stage to present diploma. **ALL FEES MUST BE PAID

May 11th – (Tentative date) Senior Breakfast- Baccalaureate Ceremony in the Evangel sanctuary- then the Graduation rehearsal will follow. We need the graduate and at least one parent to attend.

May 13th - updates on student's scholarship totals are due in the office- email rachelle@evangelfamily.net

May 17th - GRADUATION at Evangel 6:30pm. Graduates to be in their cap and gown in Room 110 at 6:00. <u>DO NOT BE LATE</u>.
