UNIFORMS

- 1. The EFCA game uniform consists of a white (home) jersey, a black / /purple (away) jersey, and white and black / purple shorts. This uniform remains the property of EFCA and is to be retuned to the EFCA office the week after the final game.
- 2. The EFCA uniform must be kept clean and well maintained for use at the game. The uniform should be laundered according to the following instructions:
 - a. Wash in COLD WATER ONLY. They will fade and bleed otherwise.
 - b. Hang the uniform to dry. **DO NOT PLACE IN THE DRYER!** They will shrink!
- 3. The EFCA game uniforms should *not* be altered in any way.
- 4. The EFCA game uniforms are to be worn during an EFCA basketball game only. They are not to be worn at any other time (before the game, after the game, or as articles of clothing for outside events). Your cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated.
- 5. The EFCA game uniform should not be worn will the student athlete is eating food as food will stain the uniforms.
- 6. The teams may adopt their own style of warm ups to be worn to games. If street clothes are required to be worn to games, the EFCA coach will inform the student athletes of what is allowable. Please remember that clothing that is appropriate and honoring to Christ will be worn at all times.
- 7. Any loss of, or damage to, the EFCA uniform will be the financial responsibility of the student athlete and his/her parents.
- 8. Any clothing worn at practices must be God honoring and allow the student athlete the ability to play/practice without hindrance.
- 9. Practice shorts may be any type but are to be no shorter than three (3) inches above the knee. Bikers are expected to be worn under these shorts for modesty purposes.
- 10. Lady athletes are expected to wear sport undergarments and straps should not be shown.
- 11. Hair must be out of the face during games and practice.
- 12. Alabama High School Rules apply to all games so being properly equipped is very important and the coaches will inform the student athlete what is proper for all games.
- 13. Skid proof basketball shoes are required.

FEES

- 1. The registration fee is \$200.00. This fee includes rental of the EFCA basketball uniforms, gas money for travel expenses, referee fees and miscellaneous expenses for equipment usage. A spirit pack consisting of shoes and warm ups for boys and warm ups for girls will cost approximately \$150 and \$75 respectively.
- 2. Any student athlete who wishes to find business sponsorships to help with the expenses of the EFCA athletic program is encouraged to do so. Payment should be made to EFCA for any sponsorship monies.
- 3. A \$100.00 deposit is due in the EFCA office by October 15th. The remaining balance is due in the EFCA office by November 15.

- 4. The uniform is the property of EFCA and must be returned during the first week after the end of the basketball season. The uniform must be in excellent condition at the time of the return.
- 5. All monies raised by an EFCA student athlete in an EFCA sponsored fund-raiser will be used entirely/solely for the purposes designated by the team sport and are non-transferable. A record will be kept to account for those student athletes / parents who have worked / served to raise funds for the team. Student athletes / parents who have not participated in fund-raising events will be expected to pay the cost for that individual student athlete's portion (uniform, tournament, sprit pack, etc).
