- 1. The EFCA game uniform consists of a white and a black jersey with purple letters, black shorts, white socks, shin guards, and soccer cleats. Jerseys are rented from EFCA and the parents pay for the rest of the uniform.

- 5. Lady athletes are expected to wear sport undergarments and straps should not be shown.
